"That Kilkenny Council start for 2018 the process and action towards working to make Kilkenny City and County Herbicide Free in public places. To be done through a phased reduction plan including reduced management plan, public education, all under the green flag initiative for all green areas, parks, play grounds and river walkways. As the EU ban on glyphosate commences in 2022, now is the time to start this process, allowing for the control of invasive plants such as Knotweed. Ireland has the second highest levels of Glyphosate in surface water a new report shows. A report research against cancer concluded it to be probably carcinogenic, also known to block proteins essential to soil and plant growth and well as destroying bee pollination."
